

## **Privacy policy Data protection**

As the website operator, I take the protection of all personal data very seriously. All personal information is treated confidentially and in accordance with the legal requirements, as explained in this privacy policy.

However, if at any time personal information such as name, address or email is requested, it will be on a voluntary basis. No data collected by us will ever be passed on to third parties without your specific permission.

Data transmission on the Internet, such as via e-mail, can always have security gaps. Complete protection of data is not possible on the Internet.

### **Privacy policy Facebook plugins (Like button)**

Plugins from Facebook are used on my website, provider is Facebook Inc., 1 Hacker Way, Menlo Park, California 94025, USA. Facebook plugins are marked with a Facebook logo or show a "Like button" ("Like"). More information about Facebook plugins can be found here:

When you visit my website, the plugin establishes a direct connection between your web browser and the Facebook server. In doing so, it is transmitted that you have visited our website with your IP address. If the Facebook "Like" button is clicked while you are logged into your Facebook account, certain contents of our websites can be linked to your Facebook profile. In this process, it is possible for Facebook to save your visit to our websites with your user account. ### **Privacy policy Google**

On our pages, functions of Google are used, offered by Google Inc. 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA.

Collection and transfer of data: You can use the Google button to publish information worldwide. The Google button presents you and other users with customised content from Google and its partners. Google collects data about the information you have given for a Google content as well as data about the web page you have viewed while clicking on Google. Your Google data, together with

your profile name and your photo in various Google services, such as search results, your Google profile, as well as on web pages and advertisements on the Internet. Information about your Google activities is recorded by Google in order to improve the Google services you use. Server log files

The site provider automatically collects and stores data in server log files that are transmitted to us by your browser. This data includes:

- Browser type/ browser version

- Operating system of the computer
- Referrer URL
- Host name of the accessing computer
- Time of the server request

This data is not personal. This data is not merged with other data sources. If we become aware of concrete indications of illegal use, we reserve the right to check this data retrospectively.

## Cookies

Many websites use cookies. Cookies are harmless to your computer and virus-free. They are used to make internet services friendlier, more effective and safer for visitors to a website. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer and used by your browser.

We usually use so-called "session cookies". These are automatically deleted after you leave our site. Other cookies remain stored on your computer until you delete them. These cookies help to recognise your computer on your next visit.

You can use your browser settings to specify that you are to be informed about new cookies and that you must accept each cookie. You can also exclude the acceptance of cookies for certain cases or generally or activate the automatic deletion of cookies when closing the browser. If cookies are deactivated, the functionality of my website may be limited.
